1. Page layout

- Use A4 paper size, 2 pages and adjust the margins to Top and bottom are 25 mm, left and right are 15 mm.
- Use a two-column format, and set the spacing between the columns at 7 mm.
- Using an English template is recommended.

2. Formatting the title ·

The title is set in bold 14-point Times New Roman at center alignment. You should leave 15mm of space above the title for a lecture number printing.

3. Formatting author names and author affiliations

Names and affiliation should be typed in 11-point Times New Roman. The order is First Name, Last Name and affiliation.

The author names are written in full name. The Last name is typed in capital letters. (ex. Tarou KEIKIN)

The students should write grades, M2, D1 or PD etc., before the name. (ex. (M2) Hanako KEIKIN)

- Presenter should underline the name.
- Corresponding author should be marked with asterisk (*) after the name.
- "Authorized Signature" column of "Abstract Check Sheet and Copyright Form" should be signed by the supervisor in the case of a student member's presentation or by the presenter in the case of other members.

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The heading Abstract should be typed in capital letter 9-point Times New Roman. The body of the abstract should be typed in normal 9-point Times New Roman in a single paragraph. It should not normally exceed 100 words.

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The test of your manuscript should be typed in 9-poit Times New Roman. The body is set in two columns, the spacing between the columns at 7 mm.

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Figures and tables, as originals of good quality and well contrasted, are to be in their final form, ready for reproduction, pasted in the appropriate place in the text. Try to ensure that lines are no thinner than 0.5 point.

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
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
